

## New Houses

01/07/1931 'That this Council suggest the building of another 50 houses on the Thornhill site. Also that the Council would like a reply to a previous request for the same May 29<sup>th</sup> 1931

01/07/1936 'Ennerdale Planning Scheme Mr Cox Chief Town Planning Assistant outlined and discussed the Scheme. Mr Lowrey suggested that the recreation ground and the continuing of Ehen Road be kept reserved.

31/01/1938 'It was proposed that a letter be sent to the Minister of Health showing advantages of building at Thornhill

30/07/1952 'It was proposed that the Clerk write to Ennerdale Rural District Council and ask for plan of new housing estate.

18/03/1957 ' with addition of the homes Ministry of Houses the Council would like concrete information as to the arrangements for additional children at school from Mr Bessy and if possible the Council would like to meet Mr Bessy or his representative.'

13/05/1957 'letter from Mr Bessy said the erection of about 140 houses within the catchment area may increase the primary roll by about 50 children. Mr Booth thought Mr Bessy had underestimated the number and that 100 children or 1 ½ per house was nearer the mark. This the Council agreed and it was proposed the Clerk write to Mr Bessy and ask would he take this into consideration'
