

## SCHOOL

25/03/1927 ' suggested that Mr Thomas CC be asked to support the St Johns petition against the Egremont School Managers taking the management of the new Thornhill CC School

19/05/1927 'That the Clerk write to the Minister of Education asking why St Johns Parish are not allowed to manage their own school. Also to explain that a ratepayers meeting was held and a petition signed by ratepayers asking the county Council Education Dept. to do all in their power to allow St Johns to manage there own school. Also to ask our MP to further our cause with the Minister of Education

20/04/1928 ' that clerk write to Managers for permission to use Thornhill CC School for Council Meetings.'

18/03/1957 ' with addition of the homes Ministry of Houses the Council would like concrete information as to the arrangements for additional children at school from Mr Bessy and if possible the Council would like to meet Mr Bessy or his representative.'

13/05/1957 'letter from Mr Bessy said the erection of about 140 houses within the catchment area may increase the primary roll by about 50 children. Mr Booth thought Mr Bessy had underestimated the number and that 100 children or 1 ½ per house was nearer the mark. This the Council agreed and it was proposed the Clerk write to Mr Bessy and ask would he take this into consideration'
