URGENT ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE
C4014
BRAYSTONES ROAD, BRAYSTONES

Notice is hereby given that to allow United Utilities to carry out urgent utility repair works due to a burst main ("the Works") Cumbria County Council prohibits with immediate effect the passage of vehicular traffic along that section of Braystones Road, Braystones, from a point approx. 1km south west of its junction with Morass Road for an approx. distance of 100m in a south westerly direction, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.

This notice will be in force for a period not exceeding 5 days from 27 September 2019. It is expected that the works will take 5 days.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted sections of Braystones Road, Morass Road and the C4014.

Nothing in this Notice shall:

1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
