

## Beckermet with Thornhill Parish Council

The details below are a brief summary of some of the incidents in the Parish area between the dates given. There may be some discrepancy in which incidents lie within the parish boundary and others may be excluded for confidentiality or Policing reasons.

19 incidents recorded this month.

- Thornhill. Florence mine. Common assault and criminal damage to a guitar belonging to one of the performers. Police investigating.
- Thornhill. Public order following children falling out and the incident escalating into parents getting involved.
- Thornhill. Child reportedly assaulted by another child. Upon investigating, the 'assaulted' child was found to be the aggressor and the 'offender' was defending themselves.
- Thornhill. Police forced entry to a house of an ill person to assist ambulance.
- Thornhill (A595) Content of a coach toilet was seen to be tipped into a water drain at the roadside. Referred to highways.
- Thornhill. Person arrested for 'grooming' a child via social media.
- Thornhill. Road traffic collision The Crescent. 2 vehicles.
- Thornhill. Criminal damage to 20 bales of wrapped hay which had been deliberately split open.
- Thornhill. Report of assault. Further police investigations.
- Thornhill. Problems with music playing in neighbours garden. Home group and PCSOs made aware. No criminal offences
- Thornhill. Child assaulting another. Police investigating
- Thornhill. Report of 2 groups of youths fighting. All had dispersed on police arrival.
- Beckermet. Driver breathalysed. Was under the drink drive limit.
- Beckermet. Sheep reported in a residential cul-de-sac. No officer deployed.
- Beckermet. Report of 'banned' pit bull terrier. Police dog handler attended and examined the dog which was found not to be a banned breed. This was also confirmed by a vet.
- Beckermet. Harassment between 2 families. Long standing dispute logged and addressed by police who attended.
- Beckermet. Suspicious vehicle. Caller believed driver was on drugs. Vehicle had left the area prior to police arrival.
- Beckermet. Report of a sudden death. No suspicious circumstances.
- Beckermet. Complaint of aggressive behaviour of a P4 pass holder. No vehicle details. Logged with Sellafield.
